
### **More Recent Events**

## Wellbeing at the Centre of everything we do!

With our commitment to supporting peoples' wellbeing we are aiming to run a new course of 6 weekly, 2 hour sessions called 'Living in the Moment'. It is designed to help cultivate mindfulness, self-awareness and emotional resilience. It should equip participants with practical tools to manage anxiety, depression and emotional distress.

We have negotiated a level of funding but need support from a 'crowd funding' campaign to secure the funding. We will receive £3,932 from Kent County Community Health and £1,000 from NHS Kent & Medway as soon as we get 20 pledges of support from the public.
